Assess, diagnose, manage, and treat patients presenting with acute and chronic conditions, referring appropriately where required.

Provide patient-focused consultations that include health promotion, disease prevention, and management of long-term conditions.

Prescribe in accordance with current clinical guidelines and within the scope of professional practice.

Contribute to clinical governance, quality improvement, and audit processes to enhance service delivery and patient outcomes.

Provide clinical advice, mentorship, and support to other members of the multidisciplinary team.

Participate in clinical meetings, supervision, and shared learning activities across OneMedicare.

Support and promote inter-professional education and training opportunities within the organisation and wider primary care network.

Engage in continuous professional development (CPD), maintaining clinical competencies and awareness of current best practice.

Act as an advocate for patients, colleagues, and the organisation, upholding professional standards and OneMedical Group values.

Contribute to service innovation, research, and development to improve the quality and efficiency of care provision.

Ensure effective communication and collaboration with colleagues, external partners, and stakeholders across the local health economy.

Adhere to organisational policies, governance frameworks, and regulatory requirements at all times.
